## Upperco VFC Demolition Derby

### 2020 Youth Class

**This class is for the kids AGES 12-16 without a DRIVERS LICENSE**

1. All drivers must complete registration and waiver forms at the time of registration.  
There is a
2. Registration opens at 10am and close at 2pm. the day of the event. No Late cars.
3. All drivers and crew must attend the driver's meeting at 2:30pm the day of the event.
4. Anyone in the pit area must wear a wristband that will be given to you when all required waivers are signed.
5. **Each competitor will be allowed one truck and trailer/service vehicle in the pit area. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
6. Drivers and crew will register and pay at the pit gate and will be inspected in the pit area.
7. **Alcohol is prohibited in the pits. Any speculation of drugs or alcohol use in the pits will result in an automatic disqualification and removal from the pit area.**
8. **NO DELIBERATE DRIVER'S DOOR HITS!!!** The first deliberate hit will result in disqualification from the current event being run. If the drivers hits a second driver's door he will be disqualified for the rest of the night. **INEVITABLY YOU WILL GET HIT IN THE DRIVER'S DOOR! IT'S A DEMOLITION DERBY, NOT A DRAG RACE!**
9. When a driver is in the vehicle the safety belt must be fastened, DOT approved helmet with face shield or safety goggles must be worn.
10. A 5 MPH speed limit will be enforced anywhere on the grounds when not on the track.
11. All vehicles are subject to re-inspection at any time.
12. The driver may signal for medical attention by waving their hands. This action will result in a red flag and stop the race. Medical attention will be provided
13. Officials may require modifications to a vehicle at any time for safety reasons or rules.
14. All cars should come prepared. There will be no stripping of cars in the pit area. All drivers will be responsible for leaving with what you brought to the track.
15. The officials ruling or decision is final. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disqualification and removal from grounds. Drivers are responsible for their crew. \_
16. One parent must be present with valid I.D.
17. **A PARENT OR ADULT MUST RIDE WITH THE DRIVER.** This is for instructional purposes as well as any possible emergency situations.
18. Child and Passanger must wear dot/snell approved helment with either facesheild, goggles, or safety glasses, gloves, long pants, and long sleeve shirt.
19. Must have a 12"x12" roof sign on car, that does not reinforce the car at all.
20. Cars must remain stock unless specified in these rules. All cars must be factory front wheel drive 4 or 6 cylinder and wheelbase must not exceed 116".

21. You must strip the interior 100%. Leave the passenger seat for the passenger. You can leave the dash, but completely remove the airbags
22. Key Start Recommended. But not Mandatory if key start is not used shut off switch MUST be clearly Labeled incase of emergency.
23. Drivers Door & Passenger Door may be welded all the way around on the outside. Only the Drivers Door & Passenger Door may be reinforced on the outside from door seam to door seam.
24. All other doors may be wired shut with #9 wire: 6 places per seam or chained shut.
25. Deck lid and/or hatch may be wired for 9 wire in 8 places: sheet metal to sheet metal only.
26. No tucking or wedging of the rear of car is allowed.
27. Bumpers must be factory compact car bumper only. You may weld bumper all the way around at the mounting point of the frame. You cannot add bumper shocks to a car that does not have them from factory
28. Windsheilds can remain.
29. If windsheild is removed You must use 2 places in windshield area for 9 wire or 3/8 chain from roof to cowl of car to prevent hood from coming into cabin of car
30. Battery must be mounted inside the car; all parts of battery must be covered with a nonflammable material.
31. DOT APROVEED TIRES ONLY, AIR only in tires.
32. A roll over bar strongly advised
33. Fuel Tanks THIS IS IMPORTANT: Any fuel system we feel that's unsafe will not pass. Stock fuel tanks can be left in if they are mounted in front of rear axle. Stock gas tanks are NOT allowed to be bolted in your back-seat area. Tanks must be made of steel a 4 point hold down bolted to floor with a minimum of a 2" washer on the underside of car. All hoses must be double clamped at all connections. Electric fuel pumps must be operated by a switch that the passenger can shut off in case of a fire. We will paint switch during inspection. Stock systems will simply use the key.
34. All cars must remain factory stock unless otherwise stated in rules above. If you have questions, please call the officials listed
